# DRIVING INSTRUCTOR COURSE

This course is designed to instruct the attendees in teaching driving skills to new students, develop a practical driving course and improve their own skills as instructors.

PRETEST IS REQUIRED.

All instructor level students attending a POST approved law enforcement driving instructor program are required to pass a pretest. The pretest is administered on the first day of the program and consists of the four (4) blocks of testing as described in the *Colorado POST Law Enforcement Driving Skills Test*. All four (4) blocks of testing must be passed according to the evaluation standards that define "pass" for each block of testing.
